



**Summary:** Reading with the Rays is an incentive-based reading program that encourages Pre-K to 12th grade students to avoid summer learning loss by reading for 24 hours during the summer months. Suncoast Credit Union branches track the progress of each child who participates and offers incentives to finish the program. Since its inception in 2007, the program has engaged over 540,000 students, who have collectively read more than 3.16 million hours.
