PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to apply for the Take Stock in Children program, students must:

- Attend a Collier County public school, earning a minimum of a 2.5 GPA
- Have good attendance and behavior
- Be a U.S. Citizen, a Permanent Resident, or an Eligible Non-Citizen
- Have a Social Security number
- Qualify under at least ONE of the options outlined below:
 - Meet Free and Reduced Lunch program/ USDA Eligibility based on the 2024 Taxes, with the student listed as a dependent (blue column below)
 - HUD Documentation / HUD Income Eligibility based on 2024 Taxes with student listed as a dependent (green column below)
 - Medicaid Documentation from DCF or SSI for the student
 - SNAP or TANF Recipient Documentation for the student
