- Minimum 2.5 unweighted GPA.
- Must satisfy credit requirements to be on pace to graduate in the spring of 2027
- Must be drug and crime-free.
- Meet Free and Reduced Lunch program/ USDA Eligibility based on the 2024 Taxes, with the student listed as a dependent.
- You may be eligible to earn a Florida Prepaid Scholarship through our scholarship opportunities.
