EKG Screenings for Student Athletes

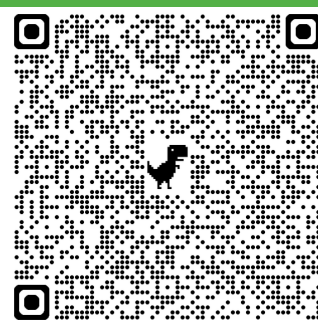
- Grades 8–12

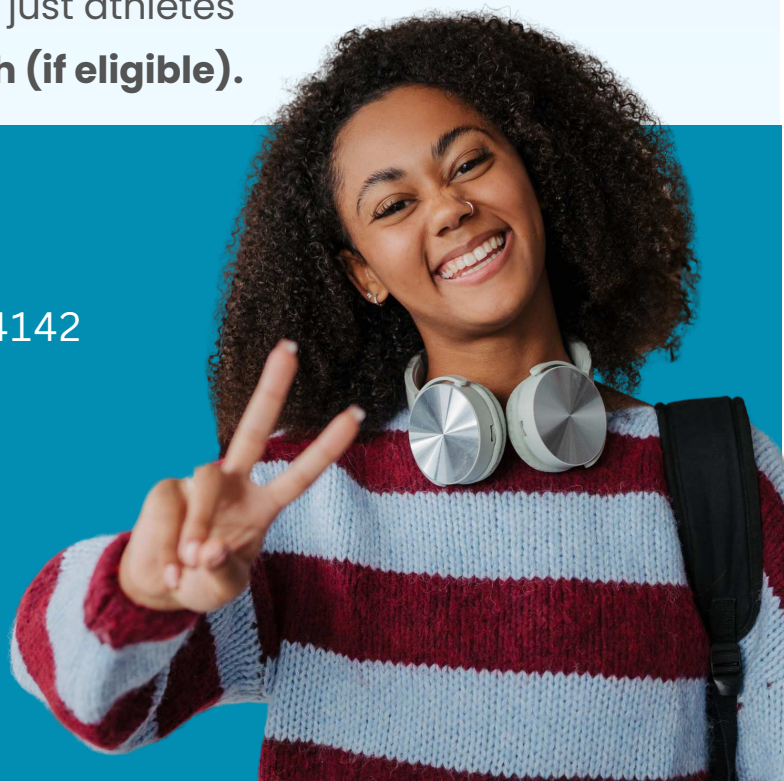
